## 7:15 p.m. Bid Opening for Water Tower Updates

- Leery Construction for \$58,900
  - o Includes coating, complete painting priming and existing lettering as it already is.
- Pittsburg Tank and Tire
  - o Options include:
    - 1. Interior for \$24,630
    - 2. Epoxy system for \$49,825
    - 3. Exterior coating for \$59,895

Shannon Smith moved to accept the Leery Construction bid for \$58,900, seconded by Zach Shafer. - Jim Hans, Water & Waste Water Superintendent prefers the options that Pittsburg is offering.
  - Option 1 may require updating in five (5) to nine (9) years. Option 2, with the epoxy system, should last around 20 years and add option 3.

# 7:20 p.m. Presentation of the Water & Sewer Rate Study, Wayne Cannon, RCAP

- Mr. Cannon compiled information from five (5) years of financial and customer account data.
- Water: the concern is that of water loss. Loss should be below 15% and is at about 35%.
- The 2019 increase to the rates was unfortunately not enough. Mr. Cannon created an Improved Water Maintenance Budget to include:
  - o Additional costs for water loss maintenance
  - o Predictive maintenance for short lived asset replacements
  - o Capital Improvement Projects
- Community Development Block Grants (CDBG) are able

#### New Business

- Fiscal Officer Position
  - o Mayor Hickey requested to hire Shaylie Werner as fiscal officer.
    - Position is a salaried-exempt at \$44,000/year.
    - Position does not accrue comp or personal time, but does accrue sick time.
    - Position will also be responsible for tax items.
    - Position has a one (1) year probation period.
    - To begin April 6, 2020.

Dan Utsinger moved to accept the employment of Shaylie Werner as the Fiscal Officer, seconded by Zach Shafer. Roll Call: Zach Shafer, yea; Holly Robbins, yea; Geoff Justice, yea; Dan Utsinger, yea; Shannon Smith, yea; Ashley Myers, yea. MOTION APPROVED.

o Mayor Hickey requested to hire John Devilbiss as a contracted employee to work with the fiscal officer in a training and mentor capacity. John will work a part-time schedule of five (5) to 10 hours weekly at \$20/hour. Mayor requests this be retroactive to March 1, 2020.

- West Alexandria Archives
  - o A user lease agreement was presented to the archives. They are not interested in signing a lease or obtaining insurance that the council is requesting.
  - o Mayor Hickey is meeting with Ron Dafler tomorrow to further discuss and will report in April.

- o The utility billing clerk will assist the new fiscal officer with these lists. Needs to start in June.
- USPS and Taxes
  - o Former administration never sent a report to the local post office to receive income tax from their employees. Does the village retro this report for collection or start new?
  - o A letter will be sent to the local postmaster asking for an employee report beginning with 2016.
- Village Credit Cards
  - o Council would like to reduce the number of current credit card accounts.
  - Resolution is to be drafted by Isaac, Wiles and Burkholder to update the names on the credit card accounts.
  - o Isaac, Wiles and Burkholder will send a credit card policy to the Mayor and Ashly Myers for review.
- Records Retention Policy
  - Department heads are to inventory their records and what they need to keep. This information will be sent to Aaron Glasgow, solicitor, to help create a policy.
- Third Service Worker Position
  - o Council would like this position to work on obtaining a water and/or sewer operator's license.
  - o Position would be a 30 hour/week, fulltime position.
  - Mayor Hickey is working on a job description and asks that council approve the posting of this
    position. Once approved, he requests Dan and Geoff to post appropriately on the website and Indeed.
